Class Sweatshirts without hoods that are purchased as part of senior or junior class packages are acceptable.

Outerwear denoting club and/or sport team membership or other extra-curricular activities as well as apparel denoting other schools, sororities, fraternities, etc. are prohibited.

Dress and Grooming

A. Rights

Students have the right to a safe and orderly environment. Uniforms have been shown to contribute to a safe and orderly environment for learning.

B. Responsibilities

All students have a responsibility to dress and appear on school campus according to standards of safety and health set forth by the Southern University Laboratory School.

- C. All students are prohibited from wearing t-shirts or other articles of clothing which display violence, profane or obscene language, gestures or inferences of profanity or advertisement of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or illegal substances. Students wearing such clothing may be asked to remove the offensive article.
- D. All students shall be required to wear a belt with pants that have loops. Pants shall be worn at natural waist level and shall not be baggy, sagging, or tight fitting.

- 1. Female students are not allowed to wear earrings larger than a quarter, longer than one (1) inch, chandelier earrings, or earrings that drop below the cheekbone.
- 2. Nails longer than moderate length/visible body piercings and tattoos/unusual hair shavings and color (red, purple, green, etc.) are prohibited
- 3. Body piercing and/or tattoos may not be visible.
- 4. Hats, caps, combs, or headscarves may not be worn by students inside any school building or while attending a school-sponsored activity.
- 5. Curlers, hair wrap scarves, or head scarves worn in hair by female students are unacceptable.
- 6. Sunglasses may not be worn or as headbands at any time inside the building.
- 7. Slippers, swim shoes, shoe thongs, slip-on shoes, Birkenstock or crocs worn are prohibited, and cannot be worn any time during school hours.
- 8. All students are prohibited from wearing t-shirts or other articles of clothing which display violence, profane or obscene language, gestures or inferences of profanity or advertisement of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or illegal substances. Students wearing such clothing will be asked to remove the offensive article, turn it inside our or in extreme cases be sent home.
- 9. Pants must be sized appropriately to the waist-size of your child (particularly males). All pants must have belt loops and fit in the waist area of the torso. No student may wear pants around the hips or below.
- 10. Pants must be hemmed. Side slits are prohibited.
- 11. All students must wear dark brown or black leather belt.
- 12. Belts and the waistline of pants must be visible at all times and pants must be at the waistline.

Boys

- 1. Long sleeve thermal underwear under short-sleeve uniform shirts, warm-ups, under the uniform are prohibited.
- 2. Earrings of any type worn by male students are not allowed.
- 3. Body piercing and/or tattoos may not be visible.
- 4. Hats, caps, scarves, or combs may not be worn by students inside any school building or while attending a school-sponsored activity.
- 5. Nails longer than moderate length/visible body piercings and tattoos/unusual hair shavings and color (red, purple, green, etc.)
- 6. Sunglasses may not be worn and may not be used as headbands at any time inside the building.
- 7. Slippers, swim shoes, shoe thongs, slip-on shoes, Birkenstock or crocs are prohibited, and cannot be worn at any time during school hours.
- 8. All students are prohibited from wearing t-shirts or other articles of clothing which display violence, profane or obscene language, gestures or inferences of profanity or advertisement of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or illegal substances. Students wearing such clothing will be asked to remove the offensive article, turn it inside our or in extreme cases be sent home.
